Proposed Guidelines for Organizing Comprehensive Examination at Master and Doctorate Degree Levels

Recommendation of ICAR under Common Academic Regulations 2.13 (Page 8) on Comprehensive examination states that

It should be allowed after completion of 75% course work separately in major and minor subject.
